1. The Competition Brief

The Ulster Aviation Society (UAS) as part of its programme of 50th Anniversary celebrations for 2018 is sponsoring a photographic competition.

Its theme is a celebration of the history of Ulster aviation to the present day, and prints can represent associated images of people, place, aircraft, and memorabilia which clearly represent aviation whether based in Northern Ireland or the Republic of Ireland. Place refers to current related infrastructure or historic sites.

Prints should be the authors own work and adhere to the usual high technical and creative standards expected by Northern Ireland Photographic Association (NIPA), but also provide a storyline of Ulster's rich aviation history.

The UAS is prepared to brief member club committee representatives on the perspective of Ulster aviation, at its Maze/Long Kesh site, as means to provide further context to this brief.

2. Headline points

- The competition will be organised by UAS under guidance of NIPA [Competition Rules](#).
- This is a print only competition
- It will be open to public entries and members of NIPA affiliated clubs (members).
- Members prints should be mounted on boards
- Mount size will be 30x40cm with prints any size on the mount
- Public entries should ideally be mounted. However, unmounted prints will be accepted.

3. Entries

Member categories will be for; (i) Novices as defined in Annex B of the NIPA Competition Rules; and (ii) Advanced photographers. Public entry categories will be for those aged; (i) below 18; and (ii) over 18. Entries are restricted to a maximum of 4 prints per entrant (comprising either colour and mono or a combination of both).

- Members should submit their entries through Club Council Members accompanied by a completed application form. The following details should be provided on the back of mounts, name; club; title; caption, a one sentence narrative on how it meets the brief. Contact details for entries: 079 7499 3314

A completed application form should accompany the entry. The following details should be provided on the back of prints, name; title; caption, a one sentence narrative on how it meets the brief. Contact details for entries 075 3559 3691.

Those under 18 should include a signature of a parent or guardian.

Entries can be submitted at any time, **but not later than the final closing date of the 9 April 2018**. The cost of entry will be £1 per print.

Prior consent is required from a parent or guardian if a minor is clearly identified in the print.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to photographs which are considered, at the organisers absolute discretion, to be undesirable to exhibit or unsuitable for the competition. In all cases the organisers will inform the entrant.

Submission of an entry confirms the granting of permission by the author for prints to be shown in public and for the Ulster Aviation Society to;

- retain the prints for public display at any of its anniversary events up to 31 December 2018; or
- publish a selection of prints in the Society's monthly members magazine.

Copyright of the image remains with the photographer and photographs may not be reproduced by the Ulster Aviation Society or any other body acting on its behalf for any other reason, without the prior permission of the author. Any publication will clearly credit the author and the results achieved by the print(s).

Any content printed or downloaded from NIPA or UAS websites with respect to submitted prints for this competition may not be sold, licensed, transferred, copied or reproduced in whole or in part in any manner or in any media to any person without the prior written consent of NIPA or the UAS, including but not limited to:

- transmission of material
- storage in any medium, system or programme
- display in any form
- performance hire, lease, rental or loan.

NIPA and member Clubs will be notified in advance of any planned promotional event which uses prints. Details will also be noted on the UAS website.

4. Judging

The panel of judges appointed by the UAS, in consultation with the NIPA Council will judge entries during May 2018. Winners will be notified.

Judges will award 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places for each of the member and public entry categories. Judges may commend prints which are deemed worthy. Certificates will be awarded for commended and placed prints.

5. Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded by the Ulster Aviation Society for both NIPA and Public competition placings as follows:

1st place - £50;

2nd place - £25;

3rd place - £15.

6. Copyright

When prints contain material subject to copyright © or trademarks ™, it is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that any necessary permissions have been obtained.

The decision of the organisers will be final and binding. Submission of an entry confirms that the entrant has read and accepted the foregoing in all respects.
